Heartsaver® CPR AED teaches adult, child and infant CPR and automatic electronic defibrillator (AED) use, as well as how to relieve choking.

HEARTSAVER FIRST AID, CPR AED TRAINING

Heartsaver® First Aid CPR AED teaches first aid basics (including scene safety, finding the problem, calling for help), medical emergencies (including actions for choking, breathing problems, shock), injury emergencies (actions for bleeding, broken bones, burns), and environmental emergencies (actions for bites and stings, temperature-related and poison emergencies).

Refund Policy


No refunds. If you are unable to attend your registered session, you may call and reschedule for the next available class. GCH reserves the right to postpone the course due to low enrollment.
