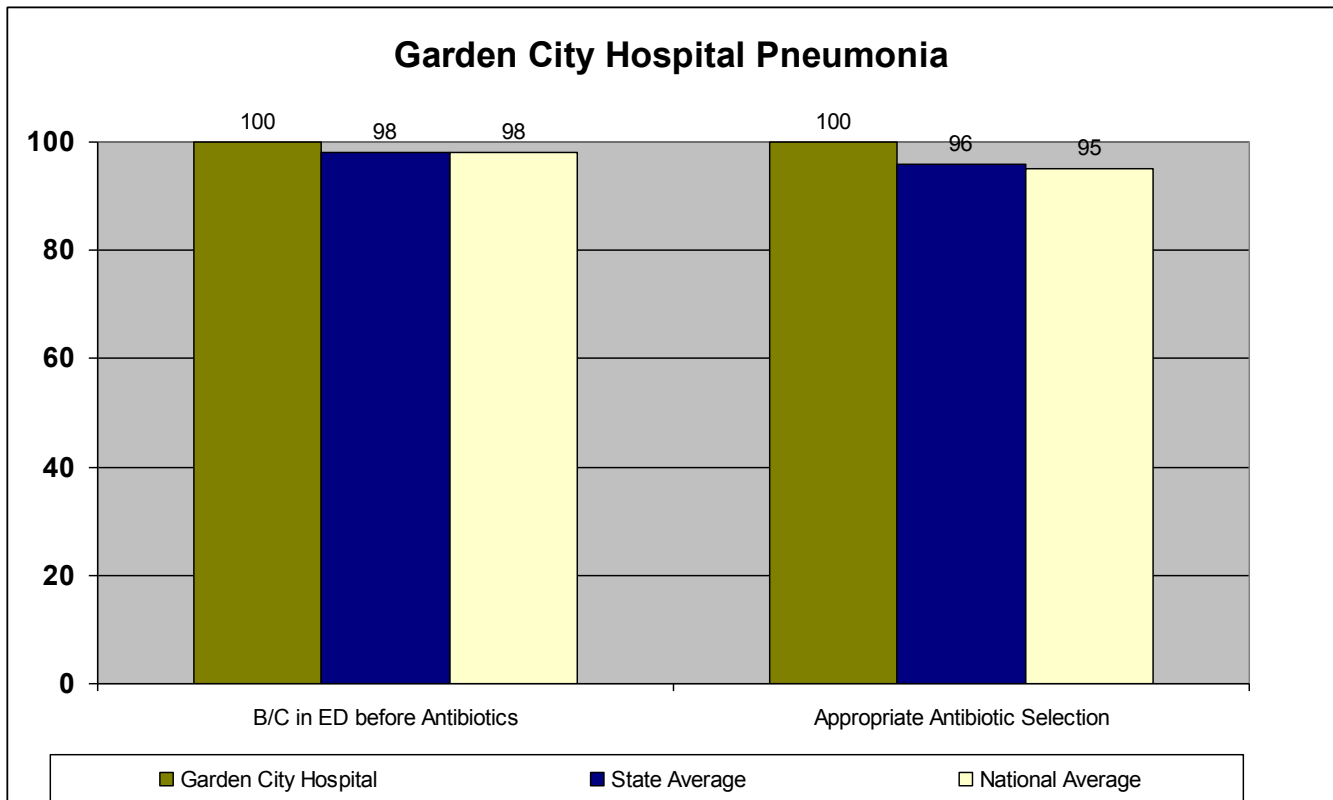


Pneumonia
